Burglary, fraud, sexual assault, bullying, stalking, violent crime... crimes leave the people affected deeply traumatised. WEISSER RING has been supporting those affected by crimes since 1976.

We provide emotional and moral support, help dealing with the authorities, and arrange for further support if needs be. The organisation will also provide financial assistance in some cases such as in covering for financial emergencies caused by crime as well as legal fees.

We provide support for anyone with permanent residence or domicile within the territory of the Federal Republic of Germany, regardless of nationality. This also applies to people affected by crimes committed outside Germany. Our organisation also provides support to people living outside Germany if they have been affected by criminal offences perpetrated in Germany.

WEISSER RING has around 2,700 trained volunteers providing assistance and support to those directly affected and their relatives. You are welcome to contact us even if you yourself have not been directly affected by a crime, but someone around you has. We also campaign for the interests of people affected by crime and are committed to crime prevention.
